## **FBBA 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Honored with Duke TIP Invitation**

Judy Hassell, FBBA Middle School Counselor, announced that the FBBA Middle School has again achieved a high percentage of seventh grade students who have been invited to participate in the Duke TIP program. The Duke University Talent Identification Program is a global leader in identifying academically gifted students and providing them with innovative programming to support their development.

This year 57% of the FBBA seventh grade class was identified to engage in the program at the middle school level. When a student scores in the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile or above on one or more of the subtests in the CTP4 achievement testing, a student is qualified to participate in the program.

Seventh graders who qualify are invited to take the SAT or ACT college entrance test which is normally taken by high school students. Seventh grade students who register for the college entrance exam usually participate in January or February of the school year. Those students who earn high scores on the SAT or ACT advance to the next level in State Recognition and attend an award ceremony at Texas A&M in May.

We are proud of our seventh grade students for their high academic ability and look forward to future honors for these students.
